

Pedal for Pets/Southern Animal Alliance Group Inc, have had a tremendous impact on lowering the numbers of cats and dogs showing up in shelters/ animal control thereby lessing in the numbers being Euthanized.

The premise was find a way to raise funds for a grass roots effort to focus on free and low cost spay/neuter surgeries to combat the numbers of unwanted pets and litters entering our shelters.

This desire to help the souls with no voice and raise money turned into a 3 day, 300 mile bike ride from Senoia to Savannah Georgia, just mother and son, 9 years ago.

This turned into an annual event for six years and and grew to over 45 riders, age span 14 to 74!

SouthSide Cycling Club became a huge sponsor for Pedal for Pets and thus had four annual Century Rides in Senoia Georgia with over 400 riders.

Pedal for Pets expanded from the annual Bike ride and grew to various events like "Foodies for Fido" and "Strong is the New Skinny" Fashion Shows.

In 2016, Pedal for Pets was the named charity and the team name for the third ever, all woman, 8 person team for the Race Across America, RAAM race.

This is considered to be the most challenging bicycle race in America.

We rode in two teams of four, with eight dedicated crew members, 24 hours a day for seven days to span over 3000+ miles, all to raise awareness and funding for Pedal for Pets.

That effort alone allowed Pedal for Pets to grant over \$20,000.00 to Fix Georgia Pets.

This money was divided among 7 of the most needy counties in Georgia and, in many cases, the money was doubled and tripled with other fundraising efforts.

As we grew, Pedal for Pets was called upon for many other needs for the souls with no voice to include pet food, medical attention, and getting dogs off chains by providing fencing and shelter.

Pedal for Pets grew in scope which called for the decision to expand our reach and become the Southern Animal Alliance Group, sponsored by Pedal for Pets.

As SAAG, we now help organize and run the Dirty Sheets Gravel Grinder in Palmetto with over 150 cyclists in attendance.

Now we have the tremendous opportunity to combine efforts with rescuing from area shelters and Animal Control, offering a chance at a new life for dogs under unimaginable circumstances.

This new organization is called Hearts n' Homes Rescue, Inc.

This new name will take our efforts to bigger, better and more effective support for animals in need.

We will still offer spay/neuter assistance, we will still be delivering pet food to the I-58 Mission in Senoia and we will still be continuing with the Dirty Sheets Gravel Grinder Race.

With our new infusion of excitement and commitment we will be offering many new and exciting fund raising events so stay tuned!
